### Five Rusk County Officers Win 25 Medals

On June 15-19, 2011, five officers from the Rusk County Sheriff's Office competed in the 2011 Police Games, in Desoto, Texas, sponsored by Texas Police Athletics Federation (TPAF). The officers won a total of 25 medals.

Stephen Johnson, Jail Division Sergeant, competed in the Golden Grand Master (55-59) Division, winning 7 gold medals. He placed first in power lifting, bench press, shot put, long jump, 100m run, 200m run, and 1600m relay.

Reynaldo Consemiu, Patrol Deputy, competed in the Grand Master Division, winning 8 gold medals, and 1 bronze. He competed in 5K, 10K, 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1500m, power lifting and bench press.

Jimmy Candie, Patrol Deputy, competed in the Grand Master Division, winning 3 silver, and 2 bronze medals. He competed in the, 200m run, 225 lift off, Bench Press (465 lbs), Karate, and Wrestling.

Luke McCain Heim, Jail Division Officer, competed in the Junior Division (up to 29), winning a gold, silver, and bronze medal. Officer Heim competed in Karate heavyweight black belt, wrestling, and Jui Jitsu.

Nathan Parker, Patrol Deputy, competed in the Grand Master Division winning a gold medal in the 400lb bench press.
